Legislative Update

A one-time payment (13th Check) was successfully added to the state budget.

It is based on the amount of service:

If service is:

At least 5 years, but less than 10 years \$150
(only in the case of a member receiving disability retirement benefits)
At least 10 years, but less than 20 years \$275
At least 20 years, but less than 30 years \$375
At least 30 years \$450

This was only possible due to many hours of work by our President, Nancy Tolson, and our executive director, Andrew Thomas. They spent many long days and nights at the statehouse to accomplish this for the retired teachers. More info at our May meeting.
