### **Presidential Musings .....**

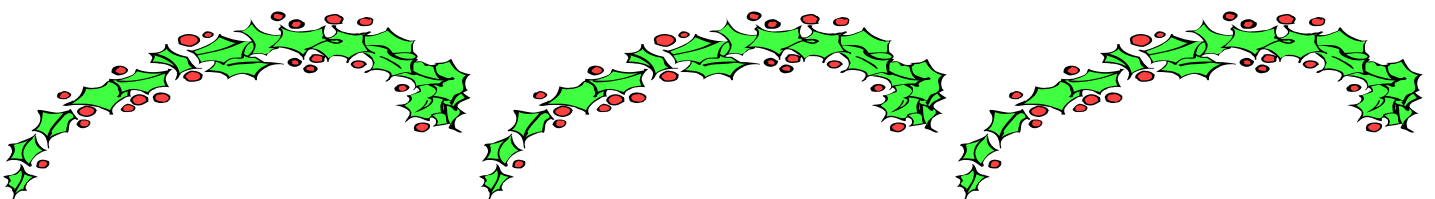

Volunteer Hours

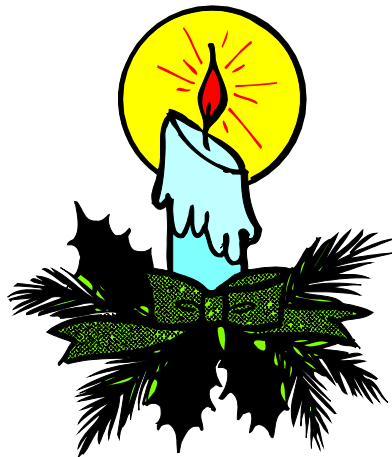
